

7th Grade Supply List 2018/2019



For School Use

(to be kept in Pencil Pouch at school)

- 3 mechanical pencils (with enough replacement lead & erasers to last the entire year, **but keep extra lead, erasers and replacement parts at home**)
- 12 black ballpoint pens (**non-clickable type**) (**bring 4 to school and keep extras at home**)
- 4 red ballpoint pens (**non-clickable type**) (bring 2 to school and keep extras at home)
- 1 fine point Sharpie black marker
- 1 fine-tip (dark color) Dry-Erase marker (math)
- 3 highlighters (1 yellow and 2 other “lighter” colors)
- 1 small pencil pouch (to carry all items listed in this section, plus your memory stick)

For School Use

(to be brought to School and kept in the Classroom)

- 1 large Elmer’s glue stick
- 1 set Crayola crayons (16 color set **MAX**)
- 1 set Crayola sharpened colored pencils (12-16 color set **MAX**)
- 1 set Crayola fine-tip colored markers (12-16 color set **MAX**)
- 1 set Crayola broad-tip colored markers (10 color set **MAX**)
- 3 2-pocket **PLASTIC** folders (homework, drama, music) (**must be plastic, NOT paper**)
- 1 1-subject **70-page** (only 70pages, NO pockets) college-ruled spiral notebook (religion)
- 2 3-subject college-ruled (perforated) spiral notebooks with pockets (Spanish, history)
- 3 college-ruled **100 PAGE composition books** (religion, science, language arts) (9 ¼ in x 7 ½ in)
- 1 ½ -inch 3-ring binder (literature) (½ -inch only)
- 2 1-inch 3-ring binders (language arts, math/science) (1-inch only)
- 3 sets of 5-divider tabs/sleeves (15 total divider tabs/sleeves for the 3 binders)
- 2 reams of white photocopy paper (500 sheets each)
- 1 ream colored photocopy paper (**these colors only-no mulitpacks**: yellow, goldenrod, salmon, green, blue, violet) (500 sheets)
- 400 pieces of white **college-ruled** binder paper (all classes)(only bring in 100 or so pages-leave the rest at home and replenish binders as needed)
- 300 pieces of 4x4 quad (¼ inch) graph paper (math and science)(only bring in 50 pages-leave the rest at home and replenish your math/science binder as needed)
- 1 pack 4 X 6 white index cards (science)
- 1 **TI-30X II Scientific Calculator** (can purchase at Staples, Office Depot, WalMart, etc for \$12-\$15)
- 3 rolls of Bounty paper towels (or other heavy-duty paper towels)
- 3 boxes of facial tissues (Scotties, Kleenex, etc)
- 1 container of Lysol wipes (**Last names start with A - I**)
- 1 bottle of liquid hand soap (**Last names: J - S**)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (**Last names: T - Z**)
- 1 box **Gallon size** Ziploc bags
- 1 locker shelf (**please make sure it is sturdy and that it is “taller rather than shorter” because your books are heavy and tall**)
- 1 2-inch white binder for school student portfolio (**new students only**)
